Scholarships are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis and are subject to available resources. Applications for scholarships will be reviewed and awarded on an individual basis and you may be asked to pay a portion of program fees.

DOCUMENTATION NEEDED FOR SCHOLARSHIP APPROVAL PROCESS

Documentation required at time of application includes:

Household income: For all working adults within the household, please provide ONE of the following:

- One month of current pay stubs
- Tax Return (Current year required after April 15)

Other Documentation:

- Proof of government funds, such as housing, Social Security, disability, etc.
- Proof of child support payments

- Proof of all other income such as contractual work, unemployment checks, etc.
- School schedule and ID if college student
- Copy of all Tax Return schedules <u>if self-employed</u>
